## *Biographical Information on Christine Glickson*

Christine Stehli Glickson was a long-time resident of Montclair with a prolific family: her mother was Emily Stehli Knoerzer (1928-2009), writer of *The Upper Montclair Villager*; her grandfather was Edgar Stehli (1884-1973), an actor; her grandmother was Emilie Greenough Stehli (1890-1984), an influential musician; and her other grandparents were Emilie (1863-1955) and Walter Greenough (1856-1898), members of Montclair's Art Colony. Her family roots are deep within Montclair as well: her great-grandparents built a home on Highland Avenue while her great-great-grandmother lived on Bellevue Avenue. Christine's family was heavily involved in the town and local organizations, from the establishment of the Union Congregational and the Unitarian Churches to their involvement with the Artists Colony, the Cosmopolitan Club, the Dunworkin Club, local publications, and more.

An oral history was conducted with Christine Glickson in 2018. A recording and transcript of the interview is available through the Montclair History Center.

## *Scope and Content*

This collection consists of original newsletters, magazines, programs, photographs, and other archival material along with photocopies of 19th century maps. Some of the material was created as early as 1887, but the majority was created in the mid-20th

century. A majority of the material is related to various Montclair clubs and organizations that Christine Glickson and her family were involved in.

### Arrangement Note

The files in this collection are arranged by theme (by club and organization or by material i.e. maps). The staff and volunteers responsible for the processing of this collection felt that this was the most sensible arrangement due to the wide variety of topics covered in this collection. This collection has been entered by file folder into the PastPerfect database. Corresponding Object ID numbers are listed on folders or, in the case of items not located in folders, on the artifacts themselves.
